



Meeting Notes for August 23, 2004

We met at The Original Italian Pie in Apex.

There were 22 folks in attendance.

Everyone introduced themselves and stated their reasons for joining the club. Conservation and fellowship were a common theme.

First order of business was to elect officers. Troy Roberson was nominated for President, seconded, unanimous vote. Scott Arcure was nominated for Treasurer, seconded, unanimous vote. Steve Stephens was nominated for Secretary, seconded, unanimous vote. Wayne Beavers was nominated for Vice President, seconded, unanimous vote.

Troy went over the results of our on line survey.

1. Club name is Jordan Lake Striper Club
2. Club dues will be \$30 per year with an optional \$10 big fish of the year pot
3. We will have 6 tournaments per year
4. We will have 6 meetings per year on the third Monday of every other month
5. We will weigh in three fish
6. Discussed points system versus weight, will be discussed in the next meeting
7. We will pay out 80% of the tournament fees to the top three anglers along with a framed certificate
8. Discussed tournament entry fees, will be discussed in the next meeting
9. We will have a big fish pot for each tournament \$5 per person

We planned our first tournament. It will be an open tournament on October 30 from 0700 to 1500 at the Ebenezer Landing. Fees will be \$20 per person, \$40 max per boat, \$5 per person big fish (everyone in the boat must enter) no limit to the number of people in each boat, **maximum of 4 fish in the boat**, weigh in three fish over 20".

We agreed that the meeting place worked well for everyone.
